Mission and Purpose

Formed in fall 2010 the purpose of the Program Review Committee is to develop common college goals based on the review of the program reviews documents from Instruction, Student Services and Educational Support. The committee will work in groups of three or four to read and evaluate all program review documents, seek clarification of any issue in the program review report that may be unclear and abstract the common themes from the program review documents to develop common college goals. The college goals will be validated by the Deans, Faculty Senate, Student Services personnel and Support Services personnel. After validation the college goals will be presented to the President's Advisory Council (PAC) for endorsement. Once PAC has endorsed the college goals, the Program Review Committee will forward them to the Planning and Budget Steering Committee, who will develop operational strategies and action plans and recommend a budget to implement them. The committee will also review and revise templates and processes used as part of their own continuous improvement strategy. The Program Review Committee reports to the Faculty Senate.
