

Priority Registration Proposal

(Approved by the Cypress College Academic Senate on April 12, 2012)

For the purposes of Fall, Spring, or Summer registration, a student is in good academic standing if he/she has no more than 120 **attempted** units in the district and had a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above after his/her grades were posted from the most recent Spring semester.

Priority to registering students should be assigned in the order of the tiers set forth below:

1. Students in good academic standing who are required by state law or district policy to receive priority registration. (i.e. DSPS, EOPS, Veterans)
2. Students in good academic standing who have passed (grade of "A", "B", "C", or "P") at least 75% of attempted units.
3. Students in good academic standing who have passed between 62.5% to 74.9% of attempted units.
4. New Students who are fully matriculated (Completed the assessment process, attended orientation, and completed a preliminary student education plan, and when implemented, an electronic student education plan.)
5. Students in good academic standing who have passed between 50% to 62.4% of attempted units.
6. New students who did not fully matriculate, but have units in progress. (Note that this tier only exists for Spring registration, since for Fall registration there is time to calculate each student's GPA, percent success, and number of completed units before registration begins.)
7. All other new students
8. All other continuing students who have not exceeded 120 attempted units. (Includes students who are not in good academic standing due to low GPA, and students who have passed less than 50% of attempted units.)
9. Special Admit Students (K-12)
10. Students who have exceeded 120 attempted units in the district.

The ranking within tiers of continuing students will be by successful units completed, from highest to lowest.
