

Resolution on NOCCCD collaboration with outside institutions on offering college classes

Whereas the Faculty of NOCCCD and the Trustees of NOCCCD have a legally binding employment agreement identified as the United Faculty Contract and

Whereas the UF Contract contains mutually agreed-upon language outlining the role Faculty play in the selection and evaluation of instructors and

Whereas the purpose of said language is to help ensure the integrity of department and division courses and programs and

Whereas such integrity of course and program offerings mutually benefits both students and the college and

Whereas any program that impacts the current working conditions of any bargaining unit member must have those impacts bargained prior to implementation;

Be it resolved that any agreement with outside institutions that results in such institutions offering NOCCCD courses must follow the sections in the UF Contract that provide for the participation of department faculty in designing the processes for selecting and evaluating any instructor that will be used to teach NOCCCD classes and that a majority of the department faculty must agree before the program can offer courses from said department/division.
