

Student Educational Planning – A Brief History

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2008

- Met with all counselors, matriculation staff and admission staff to discuss requirements. Identified vendors to investigate.
- Workgroup formed which reviewed all identified vendors. Developed a script and asked four vendors to present including DARS, Sungard Degreeworks, MAP-South Orange and CCSF-CAPP.
- Vendors presented and were scored by entire group.
- Identified MAP as top choice.

2009-2011

- Negotiated with South Orange to no avail.
- January 2010 MAP off the table.
- Group attended mini-summit at Mt. Sac for Degreeworks and felt it should be looked at again.
- Brought Degreeworks in for a demo and all scored. Identified this product as viable.

2012

- NOCCCD District-wide Strategic Plan identified Student Educational Plan as a priority.
- Information Services investigated and compiled costs for all solutions.
- Information Services recommends one of two final options for TCC approval.
- Once approved send to District Consultation Council for approval and identification of funding.

It should be noted that we did attempt to implement an earlier version of this product in 2003, however, due to personnel constraints the process stopped before completion.
